To qualify for a **Ground School Scholarship**, we specify that the school be an in-class, in-person with an in-person instructor. We suggest you check with our chapter about your ground school choice prior to beginning the training to ensure it will qualify for the scholarship. We request appropriate training completion documents (certificate or logbook entry) and a receipt dated after 2/1/25 prior to reimbursement of up to \$500. Ground School Used or to be Used:

For the **"Get Started" FAA medical certificate \$200 reimbursement**, we request to see the medical certificate and a receipt dated after 2/1/25 to qualify. See the informational sheet for the other requirements of the scholarship.

For the **"Get Started" \$200 headset reimbursement**, you must have logged 3.0 hours of logged dual instruction with a qualified flight instructor and a receipt for an aviation headset dated after 2/1/25 to qualify. See the informational sheet for the other requirements of the scholarship.

For the **"Get Started" training materials \$100 reimbursement**, show receipts dated after 2/1/25 for aviation training materials such as AIM/FAR manual, ForeFlight electronic tablet subscription, charts, etc. See the informational sheet for the other requirements of the scholarship.
